WHEREAS

 - Parcel 12 and Lots 5, 6, 7 and 9 of Parcel 19 be registered to Lorna Fraser on behalf of the family of James Adolph Christopher in full satisfaction of his entitlement ; and
 - The name of Lorna Fraser on behalf of James Adolph Christopher be removed from the title in respect of Parcels 1, 5, 7, 20, 32 and 163.
- (2) Notice of the Application was published in:

- (3) A Hearing was convened by the Chief Registrar of Lands on 14th November, 2013 which Hearing was adjourned to 20th November, 2013
- (4) At the Hearing convened on 20th November, 2013, the Chief Registrar of Lands issued an Order (the “Order”) which was not limited to:
- “1. Dr. McKelly and/or Mr. Albato King to file and serve within 30 days from today. After reviewing the application in its entirety including the relevant survey plans CA-2635B-088-T and CA-2635-113-T. A schematic complete with roads of how they propose the entire family estate comprising Parcels 1, 5, 7, 12, 19, 20, 32 and 163 can be divided in 9 shares and further to how the 1/9th share further divided pursuant to Inst#2294/2006 can be in accordance with that scheme.*
- 2. The applicant to file and serve a response within 14 days*
- 3. Further directions to be given by the Chief Registrar with a view to concluding the matter within 30 days.”*
- (5) By letter dated 29th September, 2015 delivered to an agent of Dr. Bernadette McKelly a letter addressed to Mr. Albato King the Registrar of Lands directed that the schematic be produced within thirty days from the 29th September, 2015, in accordance with the Order. The said letter required that failure to produce the said schematic will result in the issuance of a further order that the Estate be partitioned in the following manner:
- “(a) To take out Lot 1 – Lot 9 of Parcel 5 using Survey Plan No CA-2635B-113-T, the entire Parcel 12, and Lots 5-9 of Parcel 19 using Survey Plan No CA-2635B-088-T, all in full satisfaction of the family of Blanche Agatha Norman and James Adolph Christopher’s entitlement to the lands in Parcel 1, 5, 7, 12, 20, 32 and 163; and*
- (b) Thereafter, the name of Lorna Fraser as Trustee” be removed from Parcels 1, 7, 20, 32, 163 and the remnant of parcels 5 and 19.”*

(1) Subject to subsection (3), a person shall be qualified to be registered as a voter for the purposes of elections if, and shall not be so qualified unless, he or she belongs to the Virgin Islands and on the qualifying date has attained the age of eighteen years and he or she either -

- (a) is domiciled and resident in the Virgin Islands on the qualifying date; or
- (b) on that date is domiciled in the Virgin Islands and resident in the United States Virgin Islands:

- (2) Subject to subsection (3), any person who was qualified to be registered as a voter immediately before the commencement of this Constitution shall continue to be so qualified thereafter.
- (3) No person shall be qualified to be registered as a voter under this Section who on the qualifying date –
 - a. is a person certified to be insane or otherwise adjudged to be of unsound mind under any law in force in the Virgin Islands;
 - b. is disqualified by or under any such law from being registered as a voter for the purposes of elections by reason of his or her having been convicted of an offence relating to elections; or

- c. is under sentence of death imposed on him or her by a court or is serving a sentence of imprisonment (by whatever named called) for a term exceeding twelve months imposed on him or her by a court or substituted by competent authority for some other sentence imposed on him or her by a court.
- (4) In this Section “the qualifying date” means such date as may be appointed by or under any law in force in the Virgin Islands as the date with reference to which the qualifications or any person for registration are to be ascertained.
- (5) For the purposes of subsection (3)(c) –
- a. two or more sentences of imprisonment that are required to be served consecutively shall be regarded as separate sentences if none of those sentences exceeds twelve month, but if any one of those sentences exceeds that term they shall be regarded as one sentence, and
 - b. no account shall be taken of a sentence of imprisonment imposed as an alternative to or in default of the payment of a fine.
